This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil, where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek. (Hebrews 6:19, 20 NKJ)

Abraham had to hold on the promise of faith until the death, burial and resurrection of Christ.

If we are faithless [do not believe and are untrue to Him], He remains true (faithful to His Word and His righteous character), for He cannot deny Himself. (2 Timothy 2:13 AMP)

Deny means "by way of disowning oneself". Even if you are not faithful, He will remain faithful. This is not about God can't lie to you, no He can't lie to Himself.

And I am convinced and sure of this very thing, that He Who began a good work in you will continue until the day of Jesus Christ [right up to the time of His return], developing [that good work] and perfecting and bringing it to full completion in you. (Philippians 1:6 AMP)

God is committed to finishing what He started in me.

And not holding fast to the Head, from Whom the entire body, supplied and knit together by means of its joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God. (Colossians 2:19 AMP)

The spirit of a man is the lamp of the Lord, Searching all the inner depths of his heart. (**Proverbs 20:27 NKJV**)
