

Healing School Class 45

“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.”

John 14:12 NKJV

“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.” John 14:10 NKJV

“How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.” Acts 10:38 NKJV

“Who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.” Philippians 2:6-7 NKJV

“For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.” John 3:34 NKJV

“Then He said, “Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country.”

Luke 4:24 NKJV

Jesus ministered on earth as a prophet of the Old Testament anointed by the Holy Spirit. Jesus stood not only in the office of prophet, but he stood in all of the fivefold ministry gifts: apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor and teacher. Apostle is translated “sent one”.

“Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,” Hebrews 3:1 NKJV

He also stood in the office of evangelist.

““The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim

liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;" Luke 4:18 NKJV

Jesus stood in the office of pastor.

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep."
John 10:11 NKJV

The same Greek word that is translated "pastor" is translated shepherd. Peter calls Jesus the Chief Shepherd.

"And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away." I Peter 5:4 NKJV

And Jesus stood in the office as a teacher. We know that just from reading about the ministry of Jesus in the four Gospels, because the words "teach" or "taught" are mentioned more than "preach" or "heal" or any other words in connection with Jesus' ministry.

"Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people." Matthew 9:35 NKJV

"Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them." Mark 6:5 NKJV

"And He was not able to do even one work of power there, except that He laid His hands on a few sickly people [and] cured them." Mark 6:5 AMPC

"Who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water." I Peter 3:20 NKJV

"So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, "Is this not Joseph's son?"" Luke 4:22 NKJV

“For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.” Hebrews 4:15 NKJV
