Jesus is perfect theology. We confuse our assignment with our destiny. Our destiny is to go to heaven, our assignment is to bring heaven down here.

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **(Matthew 28:18 NKJV)**

Jesus is the Son of God, who became the Son of Man. He then inherited everything as a Man.

For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself, and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man. **(John 5:26, 27 NKJV)**

And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." **(Matthew 16:19 NKJV)**

Look at "will have been bound, will have been loosen."

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **(Matthew 28:18 NKJV)**
