

Righteousness Produces Right Standing

For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. **(Romans 14:17 NKJV)**

Until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, And the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, And the fruitful field is counted as a forest. Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, And righteousness remain in the fruitful field. The work of righteousness will be peace, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, In secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places, **(Isaiah 32:15-18 NKJV)**

Righteousness of God means "Covenant relationship with God". Righteousness produces something.

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me," Says the Lord. **(Isaiah 54:17 NKJV)**

For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) **(Romans 5:17 NKJV)**

So that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. **(Romans 5:21 NKJV)**

But if the ministry of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which glory was passing away, how will the ministry of the Spirit not be more glorious? For if the ministry of condemnation had glory, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much more in glory. For even what was made glorious had no glory in this respect, because of the glory that excels. For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious. Therefore, since we have such hope, we use

great boldness of speech— unlike Moses, who put a veil over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was passing away. But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ. But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. **(II Corinthians 3:7-15 NKJV)**

The ability to stand in the presence of God and in the presence of Satan without a sense of guilt or condemnation, as if you had never sinned. He made you righteous before sin ever existed. He sees you the way He saw you before sin was ever committed.

But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour. **(Matthew 15:23-28 NKJV)**

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. **(Psalms 23:4, 5 NKJV)**

And he believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness. **(Genesis 15:6 NKJV)**

Does this blessedness then come upon the circumcised only, or upon the uncircumcised also? For we say that faith was accounted to Abraham for righteousness. **(Romans 4:9 NKJV)**

God said, "I will be responsible for all the sin in your life". The blessing causes the things to come.

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. **(Matthew 6:33 NKJV)**

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. **(Philippians 4:19 NKJV)**

Need means "to declare". Righteousness provides everything by grace through faith.

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; The Lord will give grace and glory; No good thing will He withhold From those who walk uprightly. **(Psalms 84:11 NKJV)**

Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him! Oh, fear the Lord, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him. The young lions lack and suffer hunger; But those who seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing. **(Psalms 34:8-10 NKJV)**

But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **(Romans 3:21-23 NKJV)**

That was the avenue that made it available for all of us to receive the righteousness of God.

Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. **(Romans 3:24-26 NKJV)**
