But also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead, who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification. (Romans 4:24-25 NKJV)

The cross and deprived the Adamic nature from you. Adamic nature no longer has any rights to you.

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. (Galatians 2:20 NKJV)

"My old identity has been co-crucified with Christ and no longer lives. And now the essence of this new life is no longer mine, for the Anointed One lives his life through me—we live in union as one! My new life is empowered by the faith of the Son of God who loves me so much that he gave himself for me, dispensing his life into mine! (Galatians 2:20 TPT)

He resurrected us out from the Adamic nature into the righteousness of God.

For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: "Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth; (I Peter 2:21-22 NKJV)

And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him there is no sin. (I John 3:5 NKJV)

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. (II Corinthians 5:21 NKJV)

Who was delivered up because of our offences, and was raised up because of our being declared righteous. (Romans 4:25 YLT98)

When he died, he died once to break the power of sin. But now that he lives, he lives for the glory of God. So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to

the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus. (Romans 6:10-11 NLT)

Act like you are someone that cannot be charged with sin...

And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins. (1 Corinthians 15:17 NLT)

The reason for the resurrection was because you and I were declared righteous. The resurrection is not payment. It is the divine receipt.

And declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead. (Romans 1:4 NKJV)

For you will not leave my soul among the dead or allow your holy one to rot in the grave. You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever. **(Psalms 16:10-11 NLT)**

But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall receive me. Selah (Psalms 49:15 NKJV)

With all my heart I will praise you, O Lord my God. I will give glory to your name forever, for your love for me is very great. You have rescued me from the depths of death. (Psalms 86:12-13 NLT)

Yet it was the will of the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief and made Him sick. When You and He make His life an offering for sin [and He has risen from the dead, in time to come], He shall see His [spiritual] offspring, He shall prolong His days, and the will and pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand. He shall see [the fruit] of the travail of His soul and be satisfied; by His knowledge of Himself [which He possesses and imparts to others] shall My [uncompromisingly] righteous One, My Servant, justify many and make many righteous (upright and in right standing with God), for He shall bear their iniquities and their guilt [with the consequences, says the Lord]. (Isaiah 53:10-11 AMPC)

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. (I Corinthians 15:22 NKJV)

Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:18-19 NKJV)

Yes, Adam's one sin brings condemnation for everyone, but Christ's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for everyone. Because one-person disobeyed God, many became sinners. But because one other person obeyed God, many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:18-19 NLT)

Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins; and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses. (Acts 13:38-39 NKJV)

Let it therefore be known to you, men, brethren, that through this one to you is the forgiveness of sins declared, and from all things from which ye were not able in the law of Moses to be declared righteous, in this one everyone who is believing is declared righteous; (Acts 13:38-39 YLT98)
